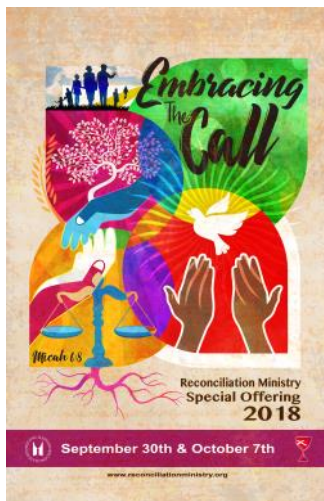

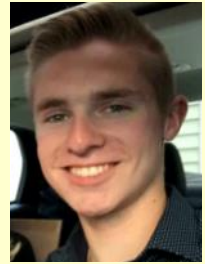
Lois Sutherland Anniversary
